Above & Beyond Giving Initiative

Through The Nehemiah Project, we are raising funds above and beyond regular tithes and offerings to support evangelism, missions, & outreach.

2024 GIVING GOAL: \$250,000

- **Primary Source: \$150,000**
\$10, \$20, or \$40 weekly, given by family and friends of Mt. Sinai Church
- **Secondary Source: \$100,000**
At least four fundraisers to raise \$25,000 each to meet the supplemental goal

FINANCIAL GOALS

- **Savings Fund: \$15,000**
For future endeavors and unexpected expenses
He who gathers in summer is a prudent son, but he who sleeps in harvest is a son who brings shame. - Proverbs 10:5
- **Serving: \$135,000**
For operational costs to support the congregation and community
We must work the works of him who sent me while it is day; night is coming, when no one can work. - John 9:4
- **Supplemental Funds: \$100,000**
For Phase #3 of transforming our Fellowship Hall into a Community & Events center
Give a portion to seven, or even to eight, for you know not what disaster may happen on earth. - Ecclesiastes 11:2

EVANGELISM GOALS

- **Do Church Sunday: \$10,000**
Following a virtual service, members would be empowered to do ministry through outreach in our community on June 23 and September 15.
- **Entrepreneurship/Small Business Grant: \$5,000**
Funds to award a current or start-up business with a financial grant to advance their business pursuits. Award levels: 1st Place - \$2,500; 2nd Place - \$1,500; and 3rd Place - \$1,000.

MISSIONS GOALS

- **Local Missions: \$5,000**
Support for local organizations in Los Angeles that align with our mission and vision.
- **National Missions: \$5,000**
Support for national organizations around the country (outside of Los Angeles) that align with our mission and vision.
- **International Missions: \$10,000**
Support for Cape Town Seminary by providing scholarships to students in honor of the late Pastor Kelly Taylor; and support for Peniel Salem Baptist Church in Pretoria, South Africa.

OUTREACH GOALS

- **Scholarship Fund: \$35,000**
Funds to help parents and students pay for higher learning. This initiative will fund \$20,000 in scholarships, \$1,000/month for future investment, and \$3,000 for the scholarship brunch.
- **S.T.E.A.M. Program: \$35,000**
Mt. Sinai kids will spend a week learning about science, technology, engineering, arts, and math on the campus of Life Pacific University. The following week, they will engage in missions outreach, in partnership with “Youth Works,” which oversees Christ-centered mission trips across the United States.
- **Summer Job Program: \$30,000**
Six to eight college students will work at our S.T.E.A.M. Camp program, Vacation Bible School, and complete a project with the church during July. They will also receive professional development training and travel to Greece in August.



MONTHLY TARGET

Our goal is to raise \$12,500 each month in order to reach the \$150,000 goal for savings and serving.

The quarterly fundraisers are projected to raise \$25,000 each to supplement the Community & Event Center project. Details on how to support and participate in the fundraisers will be announced.
